#### Centering Community Voices: Reengaging a rural community through a community health needs assessment to regain trust and build partnerships

In 2020, Whitman County Public Health (WCPH) was at the center of the pandemic in Whitman County. Distancing and isolation upended rural community supports, and mandates divided leaders and Public Health officials. COVID waves fractured trust in Public Health and revealed apathy to new guidance. To reengage the public, WCPH added community voices to their Community Health Needs Assessment (CHNA). WCPH conducted 18 semi-structured interviews and five focus groups in Pullman, Colfax, and Endicott. Interviews uncovered values, needs, and barriers, and focus groups discussed those findings and explored community-driven solutions. Mental health and community supports was a key topic; barriers included stigma, transportation, and provider capacity. Solutions included mental health first aid classes and a rotating rural therapist. Other focus groups addressed affordable housing, childcare, and centralizing resource information. Feedback from the attendee survey was positive. Attendees asked for more convenings, so WCPH will conduct additional meetings in 2022. Data show that including the community is an important strategy for reengaging and rebuilding trust post-pandemic.
