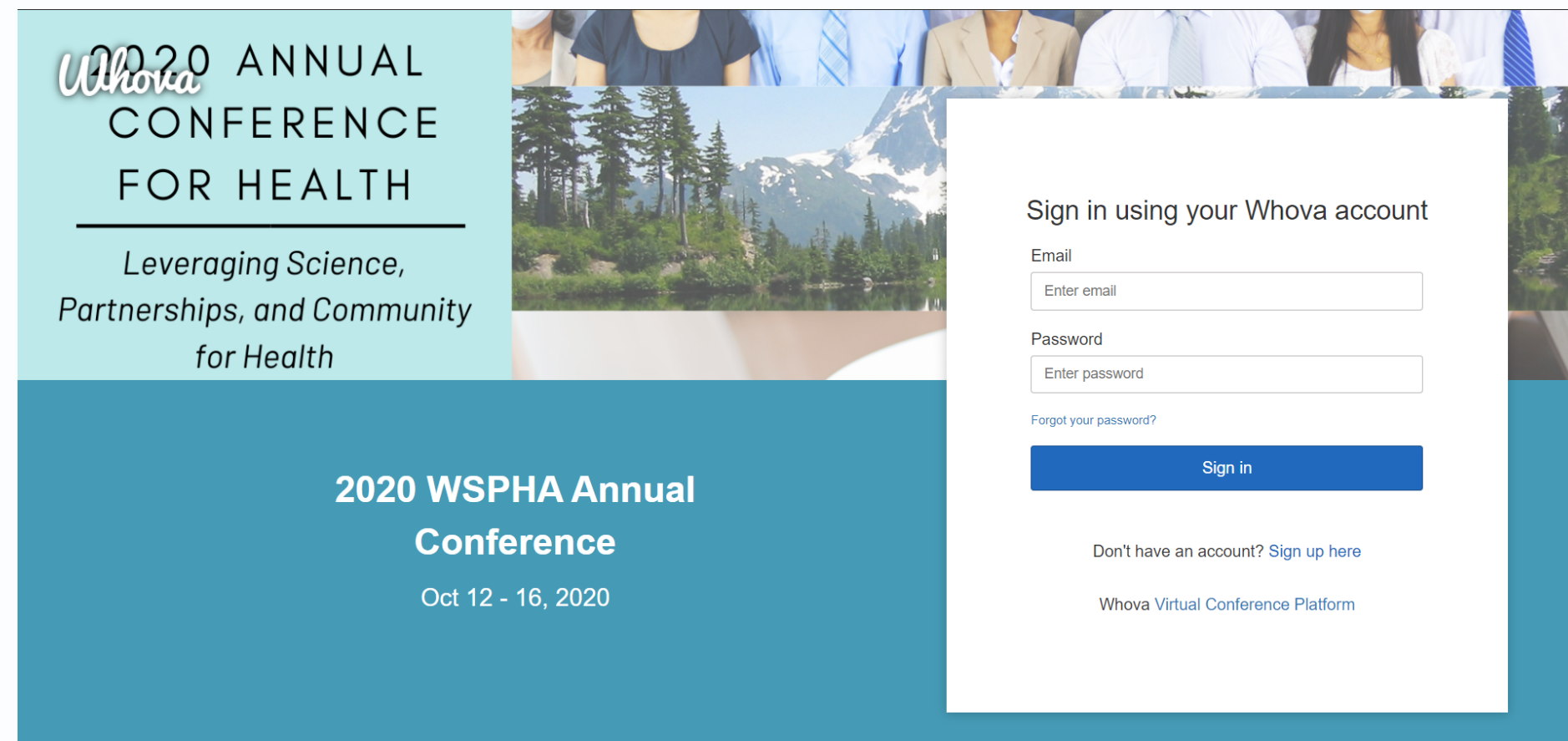

You are welcome to use the app and the desktop version during the conference to access all available features.



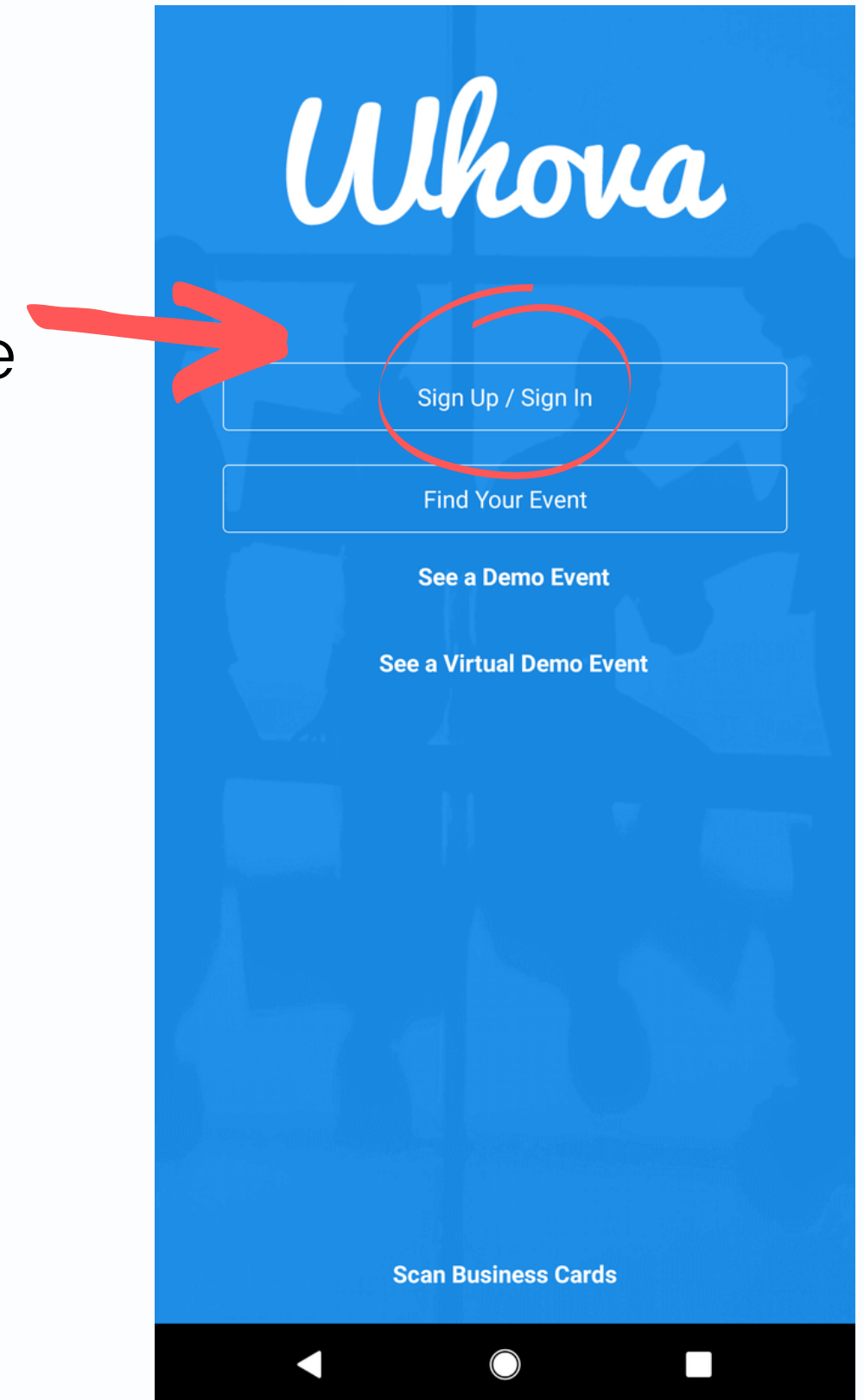
Mobile device:


ACCESSING THE CONFERENCE

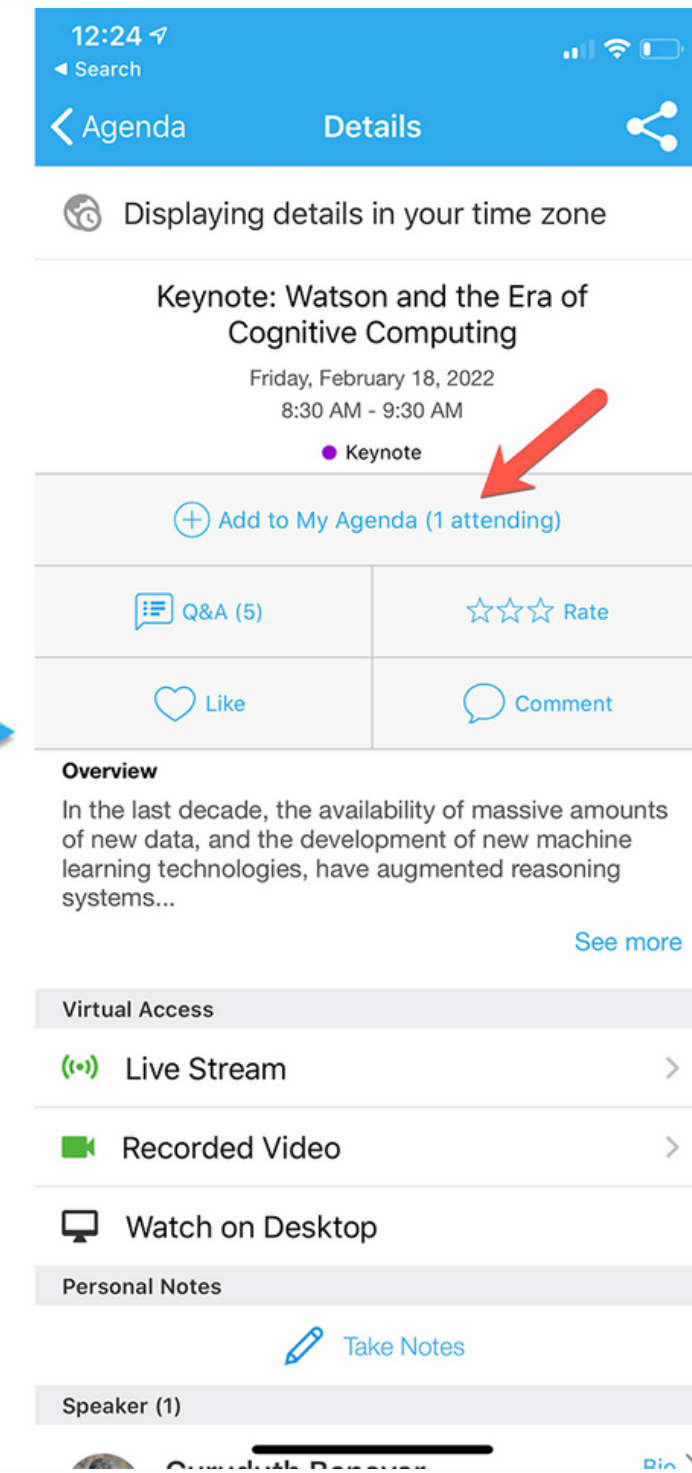
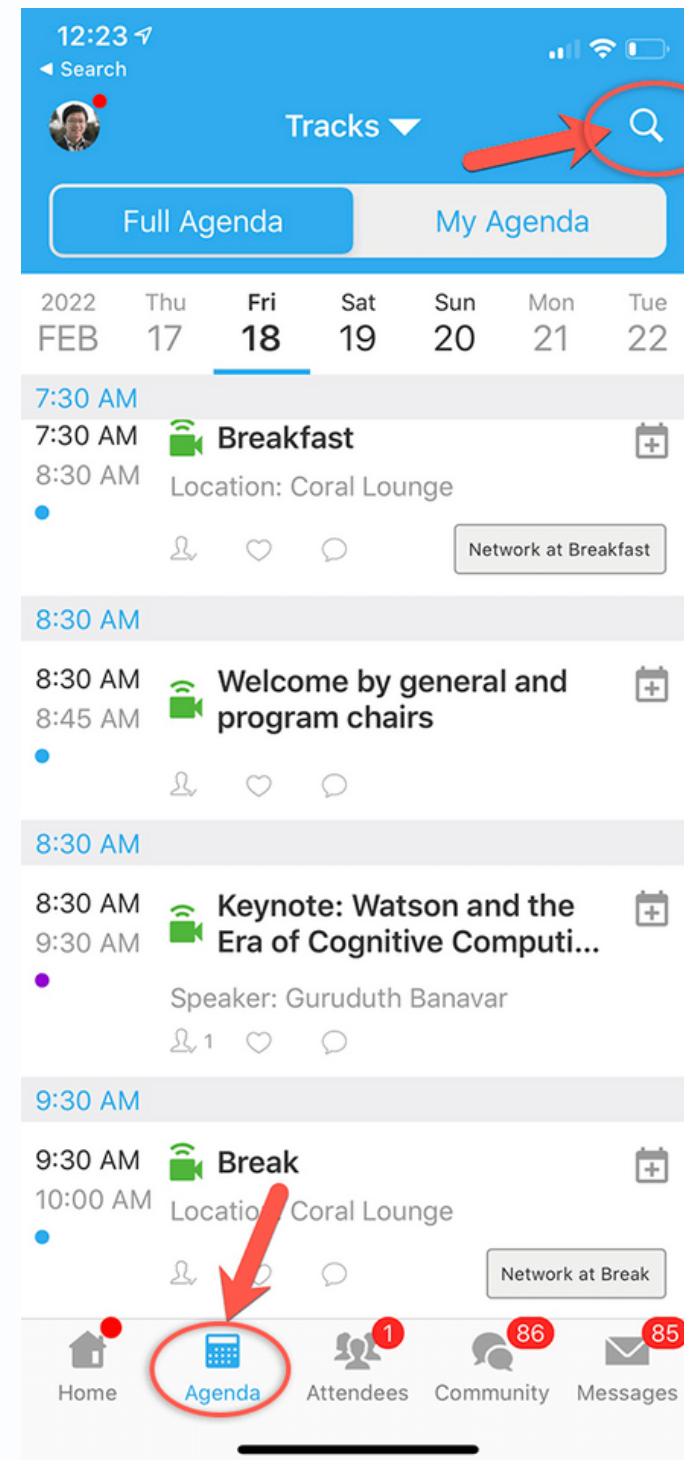
NAVIGATING THE APP

Once you're signed in, if you made a new account, you can update your profile information. This is what all other attendees will see if they click on your name. If you already have a Whova account, you can edit your profile to keep it up to date.



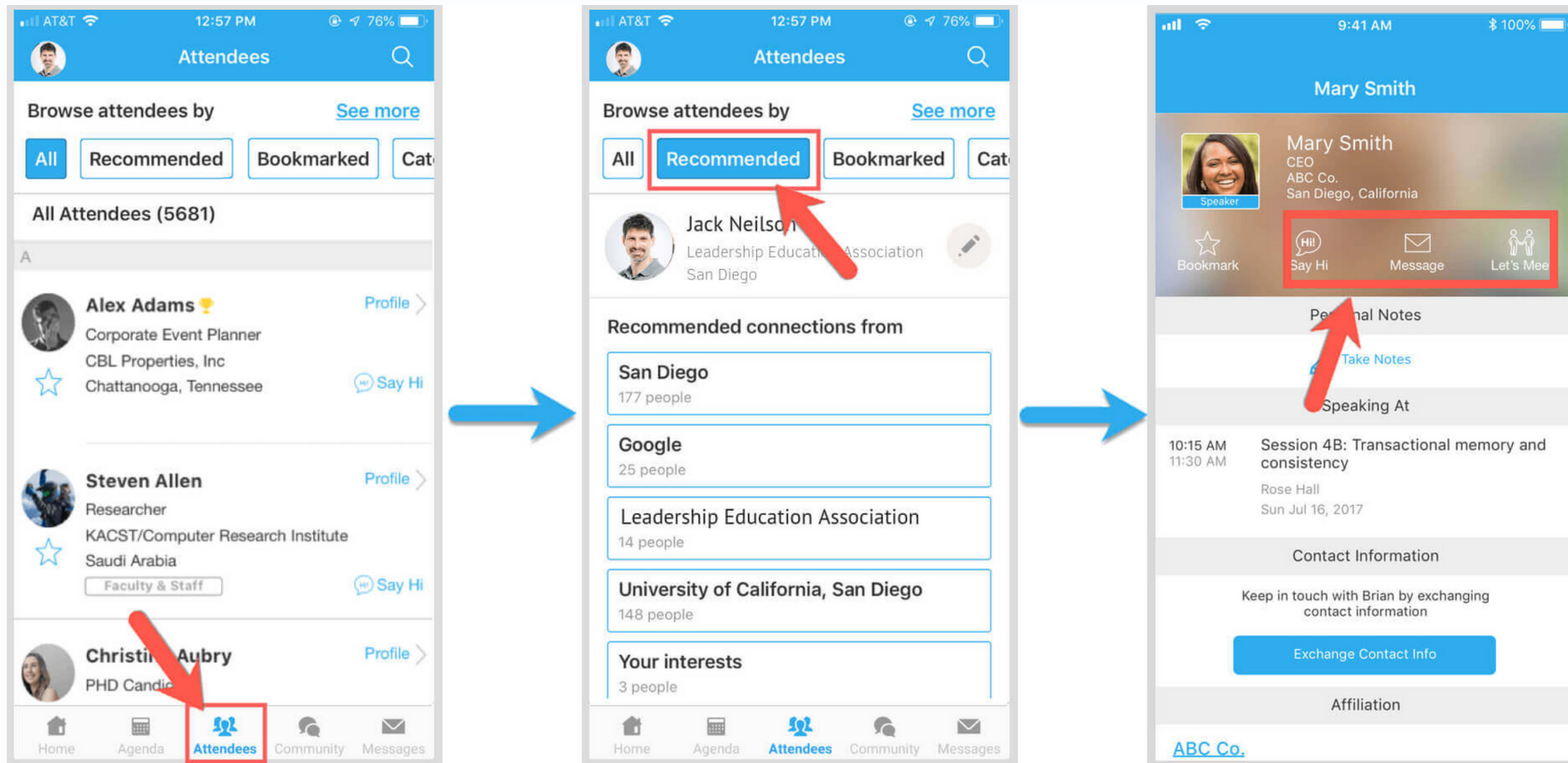
NAVIGATING THE APP

To view the conference agenda, click the Agenda button on the bottom of the screen. Once you click on a session, you'll be able to add it to your personal agenda, like, comment and rate the session. From this view, you can also read the session description. To join the session, copy and paste the Zoom link at the start of the session description into a new tab or window.



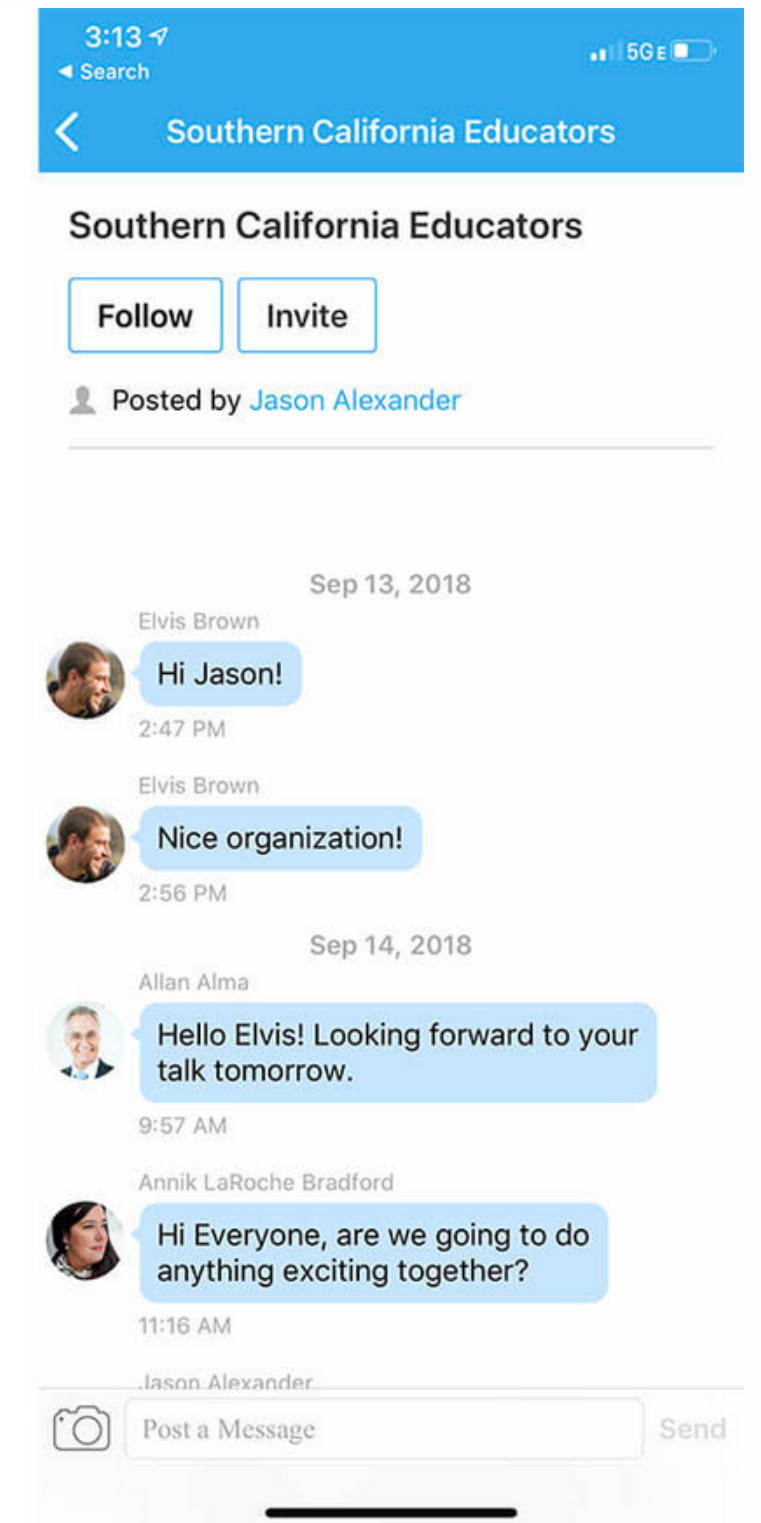
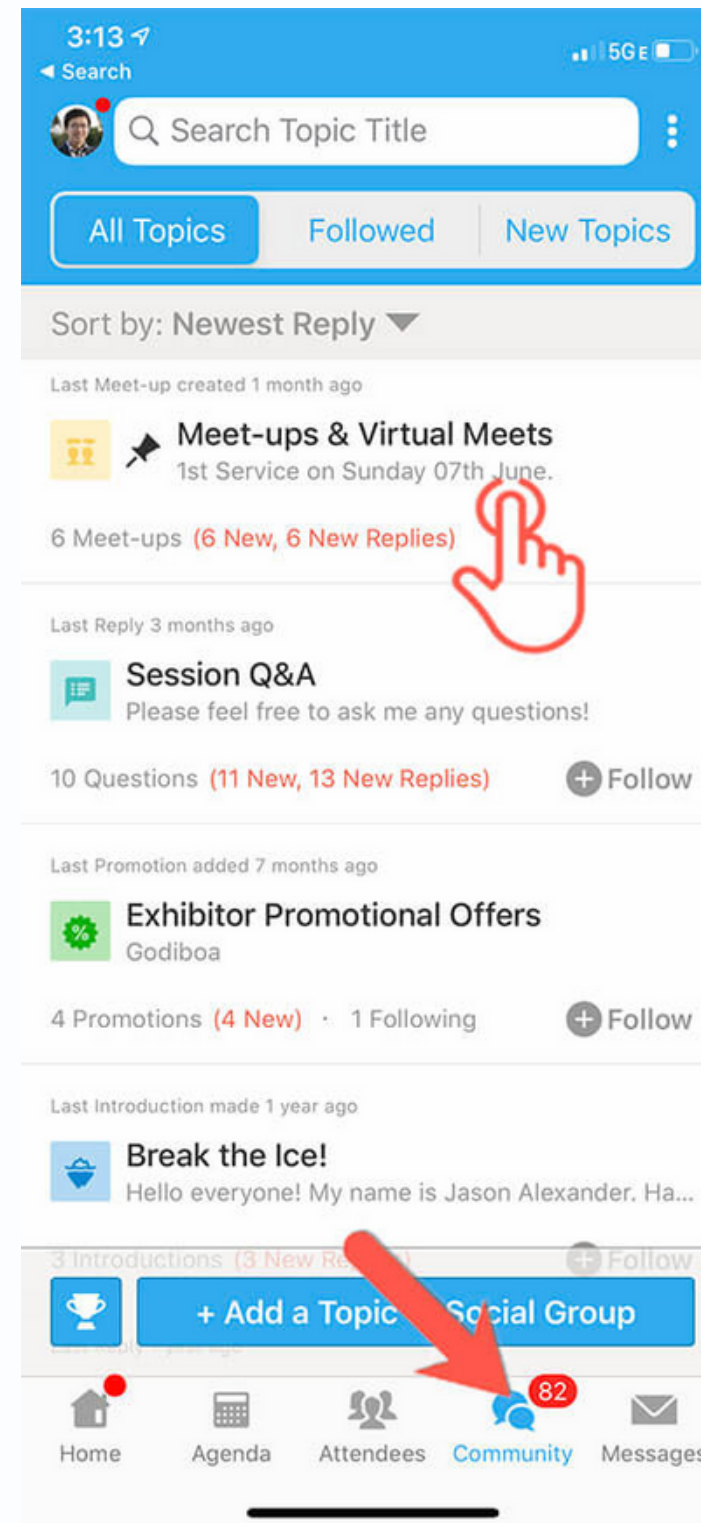
NAVIGATING THE APP

Click Attendees at the bottom of the app to view all conference attendees. You can search or browse by recommended (based on interests or affiliations you have in common). To connect with someone, you can click Say Hi or Message to start a conversation.



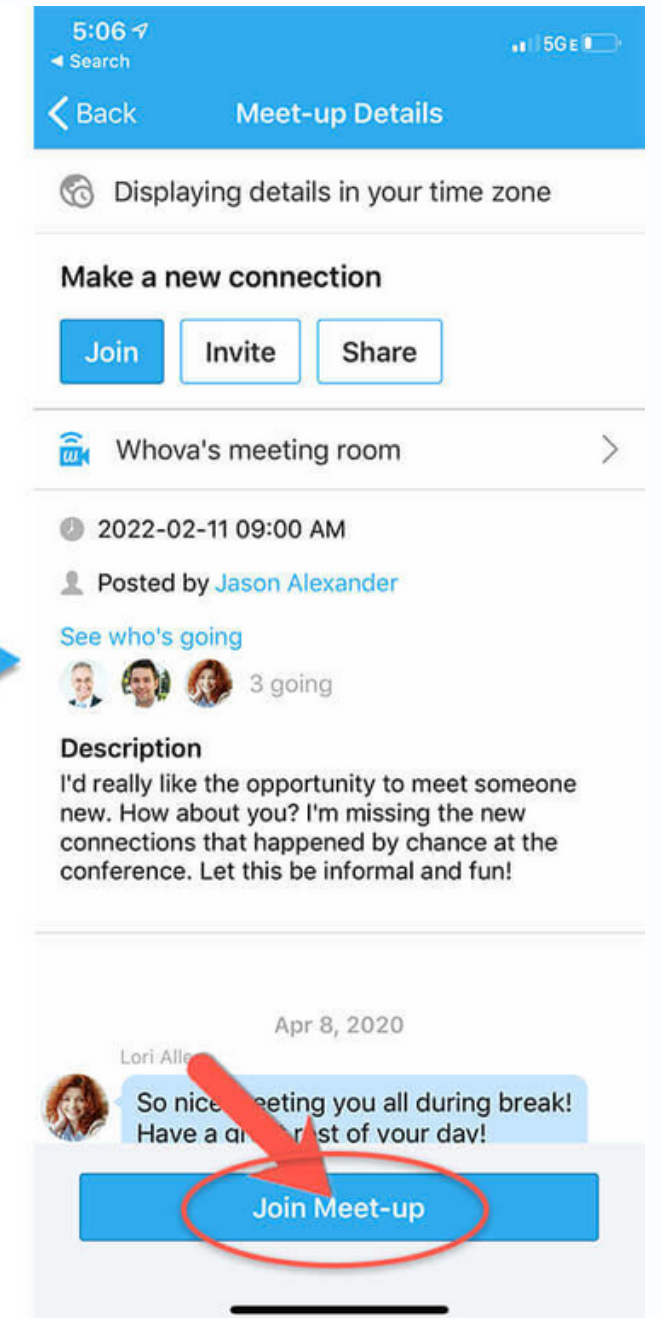
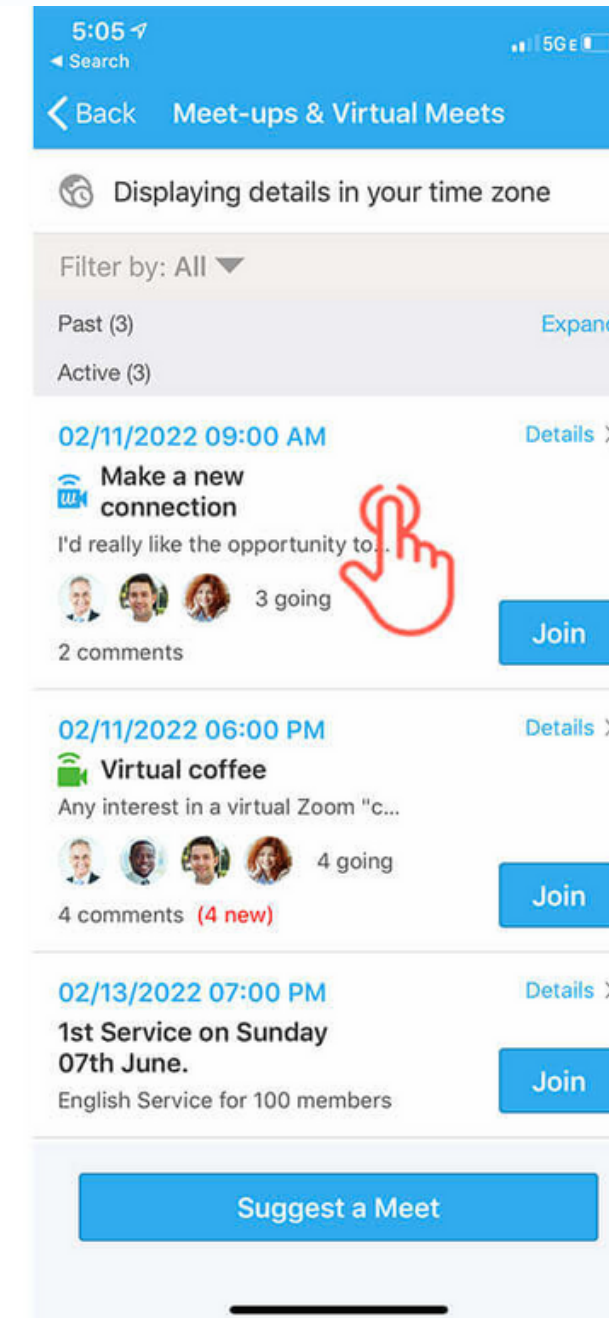
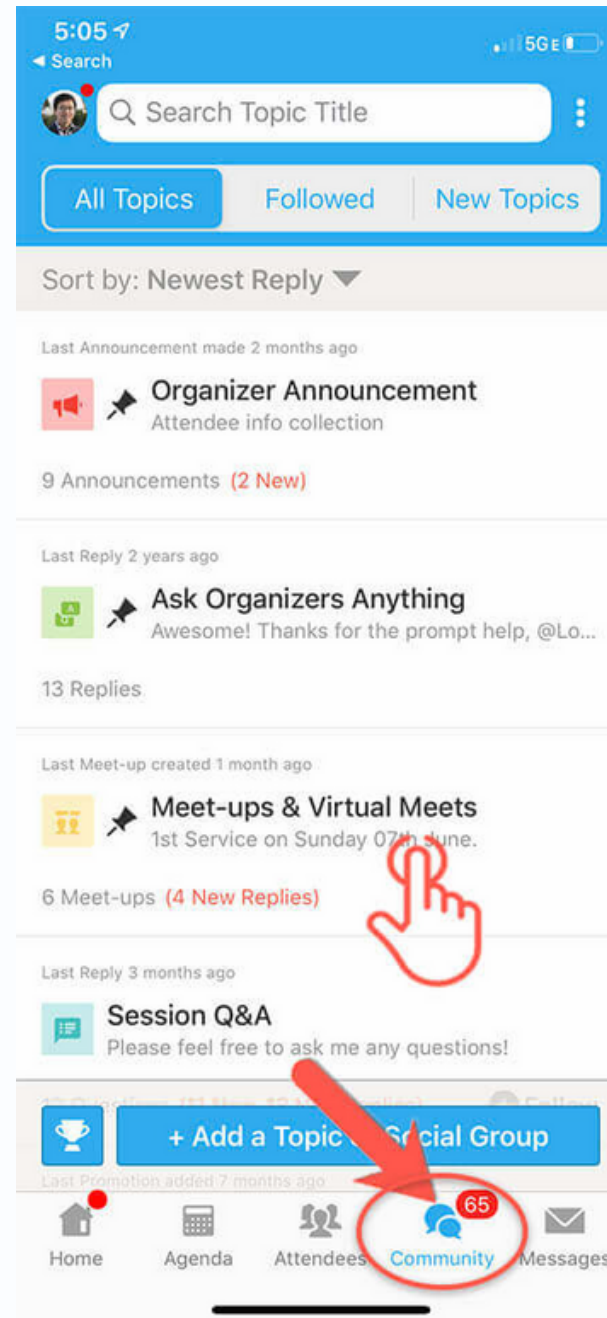
NAVIGATING THE APP

Click Community at the bottom of the app to view and join conference topics and discussions. You can click on a topic to read the community board, and you can post a message for all conference attendees to see and respond to.



NAVIGATING THE APP

On the Community page, you can also join or set up a virtual meeting with other conference attendees. To do so, click on the Meet-ups & Virtual Meets community board. From there, you can join meet-ups or create your own by clicking "Suggest a Meet." Then, you'll be able to provide a Zoom link and new meet up topic.



DURING SESSIONS

- Please feel free to have your video turned on during the sessions. Presenters love seeing friendly faces!
- Please keep yourself on mute unless the presenters invite you to unmute. This will hopefully prevent background noise from interfering with presentations.
- If you have a question for the presenters, post it in the chat box in Zoom! The session moderator will keep track of questions and bring them to the presenters' attention.
- All presentations will be held via Zoom. If you do not already have a Zoom account, it's free to sign up. You may also view sessions without needing to make an account.
- You are welcome to leave a session and attend another if you'd like. To do so, you would close out of the current session in Zoom, navigate to the Whova agenda page again, find a session you'd like to join, and click the Zoom link posted in the session description.
